Determine your direction by using your traser P68 Pathfinder Automatic as a compass.

To be considered when using the rotating compass ring:

- The compass may only be used when the sun is visible at your location.
- To use the compass the local time must be set.
- If daylight saving time (Summer time) is in effect, you must set the time one hour back.
- The traser P68 Pathfinder Automatic may not replace high precision instruments if a detailed indication of the direction is required.

▲ **Northern** hemisphere

Define the hemisphere in which you are.



Make sure that the local time is set and that the sun is visible from your position.



Point the hour hand in the direction of the sun.



4 Halve the angle between the hour hand and twelve o'clock mark to find south.





Turn the crown at eight o'clock to position the compass ring accordingly.



▼ Southern hemisphere

Define the hemisphere in which you are.



2 Make sure that the local time is set and that the sun is visible from your position.


Point twelve o'clock

Halve the angle between the hour hand and twelve o'clock mark to find north.





5 Turn the crown at eight o'clock to position the compass ring accordingly.
